**GRID POSITIONS:** Pre - Drawn Ballot  
Reverse Ballot  
Highest Points to Front  
Lowest Points to Front  
Highest Points to Front (P Platers rear of field all five)

**CLASSES:** Pro-Cadets -95kg  
Junior National Combined -125kg  
Junior Sportsman – Weights as per State Rules  
Sportsman 100 Medium -150kg  
Sportsman 100 Heavy -170kg  
Sportsman 125 Light -160kg  
Sportsman 125 Heavy - 180kg  
Sportsman 125 Restricted Combined – 170kg  
Open Class – Weights as per State Rules

All class weights as per the 2009 WA State Rules and the 2009 AKA Karting Manual. Those running water cooled engines in the Sportsman 100 classes must run with a 5kg weight penalty.

Pro-Cadets to run with an AKA No 1 Restrictor Plate.
